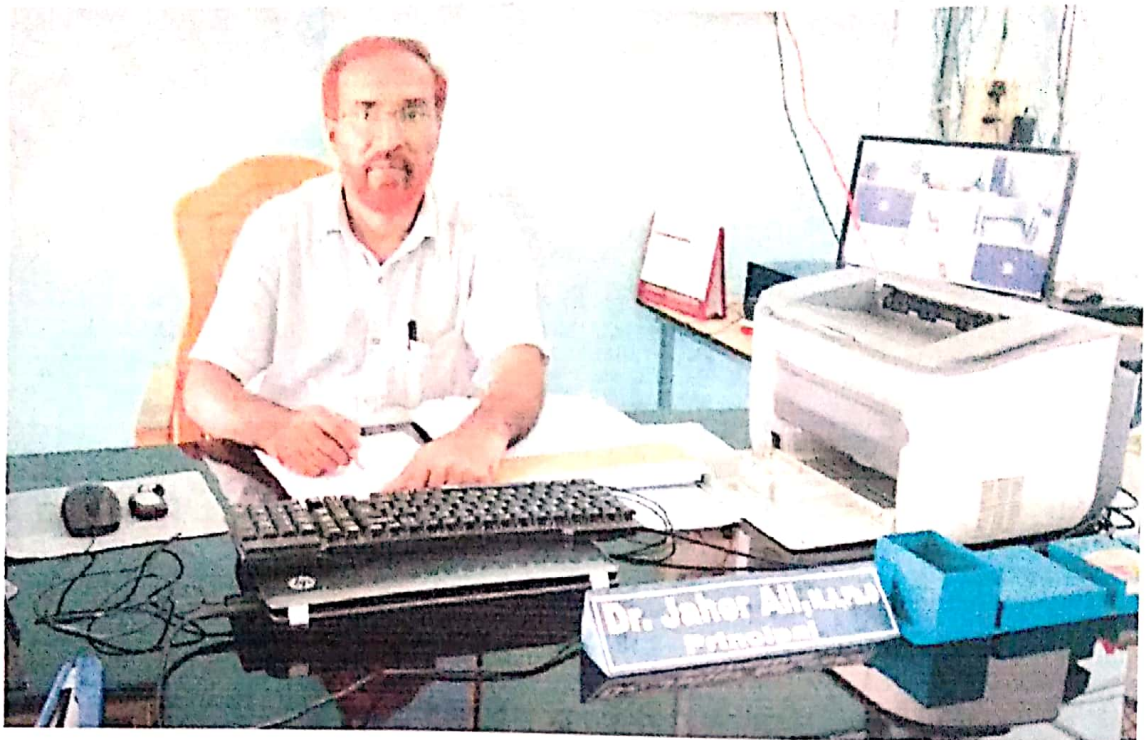

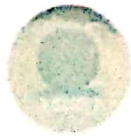

- iii) H.SL.C. Admit Card for verification of age
- iv) Certificate for SC/ST/OBC/MOBC/PH/OSP
- v) Gap certificate from a competent authority, if required.
- vi) Recent Black & White passport size photograph. (copies)
- vii) Aadhar Card photograph.
- viii) Income certificate from competent authority (For BPL)

RELAXATION OF MARKS

The candidates eligible for reservation shall be given relaxation upto 5% of the marks prescribed for admission for physically handicapped students.

REGISTRATION AND MIGRATION

Registration is compulsory for all students through online process in prescribed forms, under Bhattadev University and studetns from other universities other then Bhattadev University shall have to produce Migration certificate at the time of admission.

ATTENDANCE

Attendance is compulsory in all classes. Students shall be required to attend at least 75% of lectures for the classes to become eligible to appear for the final examination otherwise, the students will be disqualified for the same.
